PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No. 23 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.01.2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 471, 342 & 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.23 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The prosecution case is that the petitioner, along with the other accused, created a forged sale agreement purportedly executed by the first accused in favour of the petitioner. Hence, the defacto complainant filed a suit against the accused, and the same was decreed ex-parte. Further, the accused persons are said to have demanded money from the defacto complainant and threatened him with dire consequences. On 14.08.2025, when the complainant was cleaning his land, the petitioner and the other accused allegedly came with an aruval and a stick and threatened the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences



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as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 22.01.2026. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner and the other accused allegedly came with an aruval and a stick and threatened the defacto complainant. Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. The allegation against the accused is that he created a fake sale agreement. Immediately, the defacto complainant filed a suit and obtained an order of injunction against the accused. Subsequently, the accused allegedly threatened the de facto complainant. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)



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with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tirunelveli, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can
be registered under Section 269 BNS.
