To modify the condition imposed in para No.8 in Crl.MP.No.2636/2025 dated 16.09.2025 by the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge/Presiding Officer Special Court for EC and NDPS Act cases, Pudukkottai, and consequently permit the petitioner to be released on his own bond.

Considering the nature of the offence, and the condition imposed in para No.8 by the Additional District and Sessions Judge/Presiding Officer Special Court for EC and NDPS Act cases, Pudukkottai, in Crl.M.P.No. 2636 of 2025, is hereby modified to the effect **that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with single surety for a like sum to the satisfaction of the trial Court.** The other conditions imposed by the trial Court is confirmed.
