ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the Special Court for SC and ST POA Cases, Pudukkottai District to consider the bail application on the surrender of the petitioner in connection with case in Crime No.195 of 2025, pending investigation on the file of the 2nd respondent police on merits on the same day.

2. Considering the nature of the relief sought for, notice to the 3rd respondent is dispensed with.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner abused the defacto complainant using caste-based words, and threatened him with dire consequences. Based on these allegations, an FIR has been registered against the petitioner.



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4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.

5. Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court hereby direct the learned Judge, Special Court for SC and ST POA Cases, Pudukkottai District to issue prior notice to the *de facto* complainant and thereafter, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day of his surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.195 of 2025 on the file of the 2nd respondent police. The petitioner shall surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
