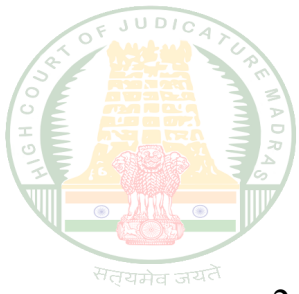

J U D G M E N T

The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is directed against the order passed in M.C.O.P.No.113 of 2011, dated 26.08.2020 on the file of the MACT(Chief Judicial Magistrate Court) Pudukottai.
