PRAYER :-

To Suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner by the Learned Principal Sessions Judge, Thoothukudi in Crl.A.No. 3 of 2022 dt. 03.06.2025 confirming the Judgement of the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam in C.C.No.167 of 2014 dated 10.12.2021 and release the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the criminal revision.

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ORDER

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to suspend the sentence imposed in C.C.No.167 of 2014, dated 10.12.2021 passed by the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam, confirmed in CrI.A.No. 3 of 2022 dated 03.06.2025 on the file of the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Thoothukudi, pending disposal of this criminal revision petition.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been convicted by the trial Court on 10.12.2021 for the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, and the trial Court sentenced him to undergo simple imprisonment for one year and to pay the cheque amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) to the defacto complainant within a period of one month, in default, to undergo a further simple imprisonment for a period of three months, in C.C.No.167 of 2014 on the file of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam.



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3. The learned Principal Sessions Judge, Thoothukudi, confirmed the conviction and sentence, and dismissed Crl.A.No. 3 of 2022 dated 03.06.2025. Challenging the same, the present Criminal Revision Case has been filed before this Court along with this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition seeking suspension of sentence.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there are several infirmities in the prosecution case, and also there are contradictions in material particulars between the evidence of the prosecution witnesses. Further, he submitted that the petitioner has already deposited a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- before the learned trial Court.

5. This Court has carefully considered the rival contentions put forward by either side and also perused the materials available on record.

6. The learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that there are certain infirmities and inconsistencies in this case, and also there are certain contradictions in material particulars. The fact remains that there



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are arguable points involved in this criminal revision and further, the criminal revision is not likely to be taken up for final hearing in the near future and as such, and also considering the bonafide expressed by the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner herein is entitled to the relief of grant of suspension of sentence.

7. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the substantive sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended pending disposal of the revision with the following directions :

(i) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam;

(ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the trial Court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity; and

(iii) The petitioner shall appear before the learned trial Court, on all working days at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.



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(iv) The learned trial Court shall re-deposit the said sum in a Nationalised Bank, so that, the amount accrues interest and the same can be disbursed depending upon the outcome of the Criminal Revision Case in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.870 of 2026.
