3. This Civil Revision Petition challenges the order dated 07.03.2024 in which the Trial Court had ordered notice and not granted any interim order. The Trial Court has not passed any final decision on the application for temporary injunction. Though it has been observed that no *prima case* does not exist, the same shall not be an impediment or influence of the Court to decide the matter afresh on merits and in accordance with law.

In the result, the Civil Revision Petition is disposed on the aforesaid terms. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
