ORDER

The petitioner is before this Court seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to cancel the legal heirship certificate dated 14.09.2025 issued by the second respondent in favour of respondents 3 to 6, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 09.01.2026.

2. The petitioner seeks cancellation of the said legal heirship certificate on the ground that she is the biological sister of respondents 3 to 5 and one of the legal heirs of the deceased K. Prammaiya. According to the petitioner, respondents 3 to 5 suppressed the fact that the petitioner is also a legal heir of the deceased and obtained the legal heirship certificate excluding her name. The petitioner further states that she has submitted a representation to the first respondent seeking cancellation of the legal heirship certificate issued by the second respondent.
