It is evident from the records that this Court in C.M.P.(MD)No.16185 of 2025 vide order dated 09.10.2025 directed the respondent to deposit the entire award amount together with accrued interest and costs to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.1440 of 2019 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / Principal Sub Court, Madurai. In pursuance of the said direction, the respondent deposited the entire award amount together with accrued interest and costs.
