ORDER

Mr.R.Saravana Prabhu reports that pursuant to the undertaking given on 01.04.2026, the civil revision petitioner has withdrawn I.A.Nos.2 of 2024 and 3 of 2025 in A.S.No.13 of 2024.



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2. Mr.H.Lakshmi Shankar states that after withdrawing those two applications, the petitioner/appellant has represented another application to file an additional written statement in the final decree proceedings.

The learned Additional District Judge shall hear the appeal on **15.04.2026** and pronounce the judgment on or before **15.06.2026**. The warrant of delivery with respect to Item 1 alone will be kept in abeyance till 15.06.2026 or till the date of pronouncement of the judgment in the appeal, whichever is earlier.

6. With the above directions, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
