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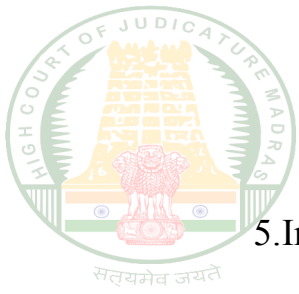
ORDER

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that already the appellate authority had already directed the concerned authority to consider the petitioner's application and pass order in accordance with law.
