PRAYER :-

For Bail in Cr.No.28 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / A3, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.01.2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 179, 180 of BNS(U/s.489(B) and 489(C) of IPC) in Crime No.28 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 21.01.2026 based on secret information the respondent police conducted regular check up at Thanjavur to Trichy Highways and they found the accused in illegal possession of counterfeit currency notes in a car bearing Reg.No.MH 44 Z 2383. Hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the respondent police has registered a false case against the petitioner and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner has been arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.01.2026. Hence, he prays to grant bail to the petitioner.



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Magistrate No.VI, Trichy and on further conditions that:

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, or of the commission of which he is suspected;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be

registered under Section 269 BNS.
