ORDER

The petitioner, who is a third party to the Writ Petition, has filed the present petition seeking leave of this Court to prefer a Writ Appeal against the order of the learned Single Judge dated 23.09.2025 made in W.P(MD)No.26245 of 2025.

2.It is the contention of the petitioner that he has already filed ten Writ Petitions in which the first respondent is also a party. It is further contended that, suppressing the said facts and without impleading the petitioner as a party, the first respondent has obtained orders in the Writ Petition behind his back.

5.Accordingly, leave is granted and this petition stands ordered.
