PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of mandamus directing the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 19.12.2025 and pass orders on merits in the revision petition preferred by the petitioner, which was forwarded by the second



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respondent in O.M.A1/3150582/2025, dated 20.11.2025, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

Mr.S.S.Shaji Bino, learned Special Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondents.

2. With the consent of both sides, this writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

4. The petitioner, while working as Typist in Kanyakumari District Revenue Unit, was subjected to disciplinary proceedings resulting in imposition of a punishment of stoppage of increment for one year through



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proceedings dated 13.06.2025 by the second respondent. It was aggrieved by the said punishment, the petitioner claimed to have filed a revision petition through the second respondent before the first respondent. The said revision petition was forwarded to the first respondent by the second respondent through proceedings bearing O.M.A1/3150582/2025 dated 20.11.2025 and the same is pending consideration before the first respondent. As no action has been taken taken by the first respondent on the said revision petition filed by the petitioner, which was forwarded by the second respondent, the petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ petition.

5. Mr.S.Shaji Bino, learned Special Government Pleader, appearing for the respondents fairly submitted that the first respondent would dispose of the revision petition filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

6. In the light of the above, without going into the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of directing the first respondent to dispose of the revision petition filed by the petitioner against the order of punishment dated 13.06.2025 as forwarded by the second respondent through proceedings bearing O.M.A1/3150582/2025 dated 20.11.2025 duly taking into consideration the representation dated 19.12.2025 submitted by



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the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
