3.The learned counsel appearing for the fifth respondent submits that the lines have been drawn in the year 2019 itself and it is functioning without any objection from any one of the villagers.

4.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the second respondent has received written instruction on 02.02.2026 to the effect that the poles have been erected only on the road margin without affecting access or causing any disturbance to the general public of the village.
