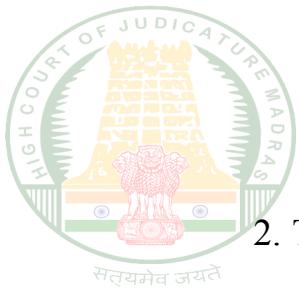

ORDER

The petitioner claims to be the owner in possession of land comprised in Survey No. 52/13, situated at Kuruvadipatti Village, and alleges that the respondents have laid a road on the said patta land without following due process of law. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner submitted a representation seeking removal of the road laid allegedly in an illegal manner.



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2. The learned Government Advocate appearing for respondents 1 and 2, and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for respondents 3 and 4, submitted that the petitioner's representation would be considered in accordance with law within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

3. Recording the said submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.03.2026 on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
