PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of
BNSS



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PRAYER :-

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C-33AB. For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 181 of 2026 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent for the offences punishable under Section 4(1)(A) of the Tamilnadu Prohibition Amendment Act, 2024, in Crime No.181 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 31.03.2026, when the respondent Police were on patrol duty near Lion Karai, Vellai Muneeswaran Temple, Kumbakonam, they found that the petitioner and other accused were in illegal possession of 50 bottles of 180 Ml Black Pearl Brany for illegal sale and recovered a sum of Rs.4,840/- from them. Hence, the case.

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4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police would submit that the petitioner has ten previous cases. He would further submit that the investigation is pending and the offences are grave in nature. Hence, he opposes to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.



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6. Considering the rival submissions on either side and the quantity of the material involved in this case and though the petitioner has 10 previous cases, in all cases, he was granted bail, and the material part of the investigation might have been completed and based on the confession of the co-accused, he was implicated in this case and hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

[a] Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kumbakonam,



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Thanjavur District, and on further
conditions that:

[b] the petitioner shall report
before the respondent police once in a
week ie., on Every Saturday at 10.30
a.m., for a period of four weeks and
thereafter, as and when required for
interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not commit
any offences of similar nature.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond
either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper
with evidence or witness either during
investigation or trial.



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[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
