PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No. 141 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-



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The petitioner/A2, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the

respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c)r/w.20(b)(ii)(B) ,
29(1) of NDPS Act in Crime No. 141 of 2026 on the file of the respondent
police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other
accused were found in illegal possession of 12.860kgs of ganja. Hence, the
case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is
innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not
committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and no previous case is
pending against the petitioner. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to
the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the
petitioner along with other accused were found in illegal possession of
12.860kgs of ganja. Investigation is pending and five similar cases are
pending against the petitioner. Hence, he opposes to grant anticipatory bail
to the petitioner.



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5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the rival submissions on either side and the gravity of offence and also the fact that the petitioner is having five similar kind of previous cases and considering the quantity of contraband involved in this case and investigation is also pending, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner at this stage.

7. Hence the petition stands dismissed.
