The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 18.08.2023 requesting the 2nd respondent to cancel the permission granted to the 6th respondent, for quarrying the granite in the subject land. However, the said representation was not at all considered by the respondent till date. Hence, this petition.

3. In reply, the learned counsel appearing for the official respondents would submit that the petitioner's representation dated 18.08.2023 will be disposed of by the respondent within a period of 4 weeks.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the respondents and also perused the entire materials available on record.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this Court directs the 2nd respondent to provide sufficient opportunities to all the parties and thereafter pass appropriate
