PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st and 2nd Respondents to reinstate the petitioner into service immediately with continuity of service and back wages, and further directing the 3rd Respondent to allot work to the petitioner as the permanent Oorani Kavalar, thereby rendering justice for the period of six years during which the petitioner was unlawfully deprived of employment.

the service.

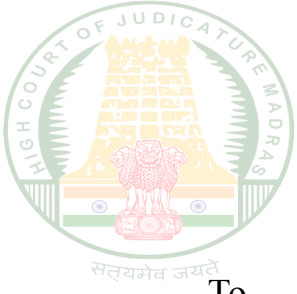
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5. In the light of the above, the present writ petition has become infructuous. However, in case the petitioner has any claim in continuity of service and backwages, he is at liberty to pursue the same by submitted representation to the third respondent. In case the petitioner makes any such representation, the same shall be considered by the third respondent in accordance with law and appropriate order to be passed as expeditiously as possible, at any rate within a period of two (2) months from the date of submission of such representation.
