PRAYER :-

C-8B. to release the petitioner on bail in
S.C.No.115/2025 on the file the IV-Additional
District and Sessions Judge, Tirunelveli, in Crime
No.451 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent police
and thus render justice.

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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.10.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 109(1) & 351(3) of BNS, (Corresponding offence u/s 294(b), 307 and 506(ii) of IPC), in Crime No.451 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, the petitioner kicked the defacto complainant and pulled down from the bike and assaulted the defacto complainant using Sickle by uttering obscene words and threatened with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 24.10.2025.



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Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

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4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner has 4 previous cases and the petitioner was earlier detained under Act 14 of 1982, and subsequently, it was quashed. In the present case, the petitioner caused simple injury and injured discharged from hospital and charge sheet has been filed before the concerned Court. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Tirunelveli

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District, and on further conditions that :-

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[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the Judicial Magistrate No.III, Tirunelveli, daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is



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released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
