ORDER

The Writ Petition is filed for a Mandamus not to take any further action pursuant to the order, dated 07.01.2026 passed by the 2nd respondent in M.P.No.117 of 2024.

2.The contention of the petitioner is that when the above order is passed under Section 78 of the HR & CE Act, the petitioner has preferred a revision in R.P.No.100 of 2026 and the petitioner has also made prayers for interim relief. Without even taking up the interim relief, now the respondents are implementing the order of eviction passed against the petitioner and therefore, the petitioner is before this Court.
