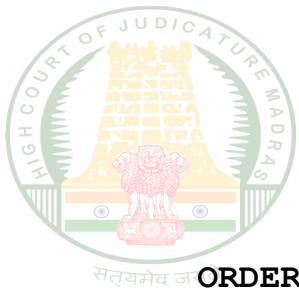

PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Section 482
of B.N.S.S.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.108 of 2026 on
the file of the Respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

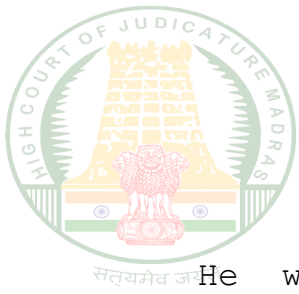
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The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence under Sections 140(3), 142 BNS in Crime No.108 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that there existed a money dispute between the parties, due to which the petitioner along with other accused persons abducted the defacto complainant, tortured him and forcibly took money and other articles from him. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. The learned Counsel for the State of Tamil Nadu appearing for the respondent police would submit that the petitioner is having one previous case under Section 379 of IPC which pertains to the year 2018.



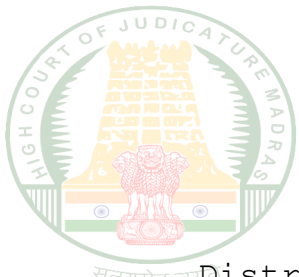
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He would further submit that the co-accused had already obtained anticipatory bail before this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD).No.9619 of 2026. He would further submit that the amount and jewels have been recovered and that two cars were involved in the occurrence. According to the prosecution, one of the cars is yet to be recovered.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that the property has been recovered from the accused persons as stated by the prosecution and also the fact that the co-accused had already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Guziliamparai, Dindigul



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District on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

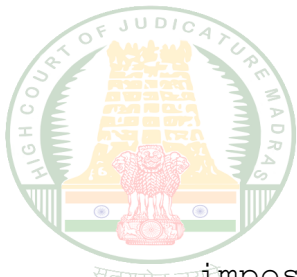
[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b]the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of one month and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been



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imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**;

[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS, 2023.
