PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.86 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police

for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 318(4), 351(2), 316(5) of BNS in Crime No.86 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners had contacted the de-facto complainant who is running a paddy procurement shop. The petitioners had purchased the paddy from the de-facto complainant. The petitioners had cheated the de-facto complainant to the tune of Rs. 22,10,000/- under the guise of paddy business. He had also threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, a case has been registered.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they have not committed any offence. He seeks this Court to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Further, the petitioners are having 5 previous cases which are similar in nature.

5. This Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioners are doing the same offence repeatedly and the modus operandi is same. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature and gravity of the offence, previous antecedents and the specific overt act against the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners at this stage.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
