PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 6 % p.a. on the delayed disbursement of the petitioner's terminal benefits, including Provident Fund, Gratuity, Terminal Leave Salary and Commuted Value of Pension for the period from the date of the petitioner's retirement till the date of actual disbursement and consequently, direct the respondent to settle the same to the petitioner within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

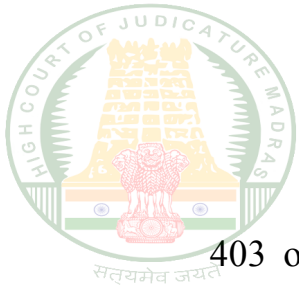
ORDER

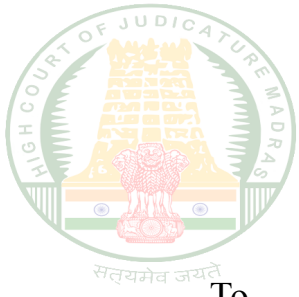
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403 of 2010 and batch, dated 07.04.2014 and W.A.(MD) No.1419 of 2021 and batch, dated 26.07.2021.

In the said circumstances, this writ petition is allowed and the respondent is directed to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of the petitioner's terminal benefits, including Provident Fund, Gratuity, Terminal Leave Salary and Commuted Value of Pension and other monetary benefits from the date of his retirement till the date on which the terminal benefits are paid to the petitioner. The respondent is further directed to comply with the said direction as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of FIVE MONTHS from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
