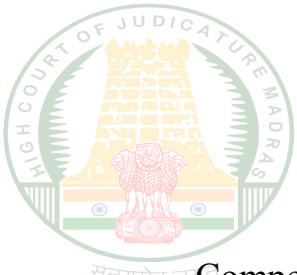

These petitions have been filed to implead the accused persons in the main criminal revision cases, since the main Criminal Revision cases cannot be considered without issuing notice to the accused persons.

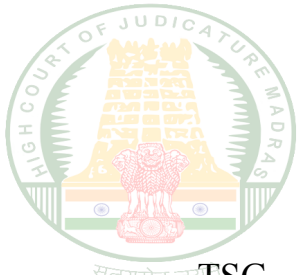
2. Heard the learned counsel on either side.
