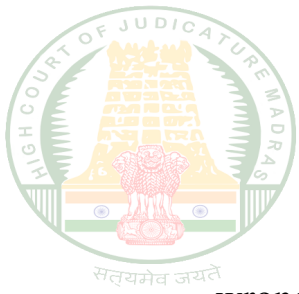

When the matter came up for hearing today, the learned Government Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submitted that, upon noticing the error that had crept into the records, necessary consequential proceedings were initiated and, ultimately, on 15.06.2026, the error was rectified. It is further submitted that the original document bearing Doc. No. 680 of 2023 was also handed over to the petitioner on 15.06.2026.

4. Recording the same, the writ petition stands closed. No costs.
