ORDER

When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that, after the present FIR, four more cases have been filed against the petitioner and the same are pending investigation. The allegation against the petitioner is that he



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had kept bundles of Rs.100 notes containing only two genuine notes, and the remaining notes were counterfeit.

2. Considering the nature of offence, the court is not entitled to entertain this petition.

3. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
