**ORDER****(Order of the Court was delivered by G.R.SWAMINATHAN, J.)**

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 5 and the learned counsel appearing for the sixth respondent.

2. The respondents concede that survey No.732/18B belongs to the writ petitioner. But their allegation is that the petitioner had also encroached upon the adjacent Adhidravidar natham land and that is



why, action was taken in respect of the petitioner's occupation in survey No.732/6. The petitioner's counsel would argue that survey was not done properly. But, that would be a different cause of action altogether. The scope of this writ petition is to protect the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petition-mentioned land in survey No.732/18B. On this, there is no dispute whatsoever. Recording the stand of the respondents that they would not disturb the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petition-mentioned land in survey No.732/18B, this writ petition stands allowed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
