ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for a mandamus directing the 4th and 5th respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 03.10.2023 for removing the establishment of road and Electricity post from the petitioner's property, which is situated at Plot 21 in Survey No. 399, Avaniyapuram, Madurai district within a stipulated time as prescribed by this Court.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Special Government Pleader for the respondent 1 to 3 and the learned counsel for the respondents 4 and 5.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner made a representation to the respondents 4 and 5 to remove the establishment of road and electricity post in the petitioner's property.
