ORDER

The petitioner with a grievance that the terminal benefits due to him have not been settled by the respondents has filed WP(MD)No.6020 of 2025 before this court and this court by order dated 21.03.2025 has disposed the writ petition as follows:

“8.Accordingly, the first respondent is directed to pass orders on the proposal sent by the third respondent in R.C.No. 204/2024/A1 dated 14.03.2025 to settle the terminal benefits to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The respondents are directed to take steps to disburse the terminal benefits to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter. There shall be no order as to costs.”

2.The petitioner has filed a contempt petition that the above orders of this court has not been complied with.
