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ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition has been filed challenging the order dated 30.06.2025 made in I.A.No.3 of 2023 in IDOP.No.305 of 2022 on the file of the Family Court, Kanyakumari at Nagercoil.

2.Heard the learned counsel on either side.

3.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, it is informed by the learned counsel on either side that the matter has been settled between the parties amicably and a settlement agreement, dated 03.02.2026, was also made between them. They would therefore pray this Court that the Civil Revision Petition may be closed, in terms of the settlement agreement entered between the parties.

4.The settlement agreement, dated 03.02.2026, is reproduced herein below:-



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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT entered into on 03.02.2026
between M. Augustin, Petitioner

and
S. Daisy Janet, Respondent

WHEREAS

1. Disputes and difference had arisen between the Parties hereto and CRP(MD). No.3642/2025 was filed on 08.01.2026 before Hon'ble High Court Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai
2. The matter was referred to mediation / conciliation vide an order dated 22.01.2026 passed by Madurai Bench of Madras High Court
3. The parties agreed that J. Susheela Devi & U. Giri Kumar would act as their Mediator / Conciliator Co. Mediator
4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation / Conciliation from 22.01.2026 to 03.02.2026 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator / Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.
5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and their own free will arrived at this Settlement Agreement in the presence of the Mediator / Conciliator.



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the compromise to the satisfaction of both parties, the dispute between the petitioner and the Respondent have been amicably settled out of court.

The petitioner states that he is unable to pay monthly maintenance of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only). In lieu thereof, he has agreed to transfer the property purchased by him, bearing R.G.No. 244/1, Plot No. 1, Patta No. 1314, extent 3 aca situated at Eranthimangalam Village, and R.G.No. 244/1, S. No. 244/4 that also has road access and transport facilities in favour of his wife, the Respondent herein by executing a valid and proper Deed of Conveyance at Respondent's own cost. The Respondent hereby agrees and gives her consent to the above agreement.

The petitioner further undertakes to deposit a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) in TDS, The Hindu Branch, S.B.A. No. 0251000056079 in the name of his daughter Ms. Celcia Tharshini A.D. to be used for her expenses.

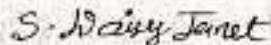
The petitioner also agrees to execute a Settlement Deed with life estate, forthwith bequeathing his remaining properties equally in favour of his two children. This compromise has been entered into voluntarily, without any coercion, Undue influence.

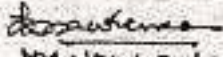
Both parties state that they have mutually agreed to dissolve their marriage and undertake to file a petition for obtaining a decree of divorce by mutual consent before the competent court.

By signing this Agreement the Parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to CRP (MD) NO. 6242/2025 (Case No.) and all disputes and difference in this regard have been amicably settled by the Parties hereto through the process of conciliation / Mediation.
