ORDER

The delay of 832 days in re-presenting the Second Appeal papers is sought to be condoned.

2.I have heard Mr.R.R.Kannan, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr.R.Thangapandian, learned Counsel for the contesting first respondent.

3.Learned Counsel for the petitioner stated that the delay occasioned only on account of the learned Counsel having shifted the office twice. Meantime, the papers got misplaced and hence, delay occasioned.
