Challenging the inquiry notice dated 10.12.2025 issued by the fourth respondent, the present writ petition has been filed.

2. By consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself. Having regard to the nature of the order proposed to be passed in this writ petition, notice to the sixth respondent is dispensed with.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, although a civil dispute is pending in respect of the subject property, the fourth
