Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to survey, measure and fix the boundary stones in respect of the petitioner's property comprised in Survey No.408/3E an extents of 15 Cents (0.6.00 Hectares) situated at Kayampatti, Kongampatti Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District on the basis of the petitioner's Application dated 21.01.2025 within time stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to survey, measure and fix boundary stones in respect of the petitioner's property comprised in Survey No. 408/3E, measuring an extent of 15 cents (0.06.00 hectares), situated at Kayampatti, Kongampatti Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District, on the basis of the petitioner's application dated 21.01.2025, within the time stipulated by this Court.

2. With the consent of the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that an online application has been made for the demarcation of the boundaries of the property in question.

4. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that after consideration of the claims of the parties, proper



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steps would be taken to demarcate the land in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923.

5. Recording the aforesaid submissions, this Court directs the respondents to consider the online application of the petitioner dated 21.01.2025, demarcate the petitioner's land after consideration of the claims of all parties and pass orders in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event of any rival claims, the parties are at liberty to pursue their remedies before the Civil Court.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
