PRAYER :- C-6 AB. To enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest concerned in SC No. 155/2022 learned I Additional District Judge, Thoothukudi, in the file of the Inspector of Police, Sathankulam Police Station, Thoothukudi on such terms and condition.
