ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') seeking to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 & 2 in Crime No.157 of 2025, on the file of Garla Police Station, Mahabubabad District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 324(4) and 351(2) read with 3(5) of BNS, 2023.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted a copy of instructions

received from Sub-Inspector of Police, Garla Police Station, Mahabubabad District which discloses that charge sheet is filed before the Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Mahabubabad, on 30.12.2025 and C.C. number is awaited.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioners has sought permission to withdraw the Criminal Petition.

4. Permission, as prayed for, is accorded.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to the petitioners to seek appropriate remedies in accordance with law.

6. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.

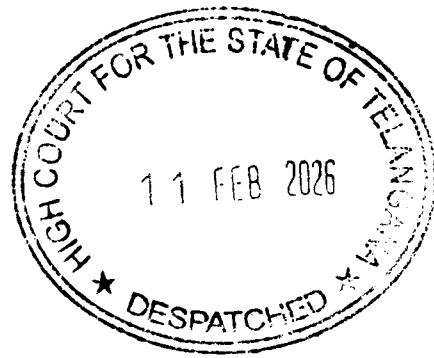
