Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondents more particularly that of respondent no.2 in issuing show cause notice dated 31.05.2023 vide Show Cause Notice No.166/Admn/2023 directing the petitioner to submit explanation during incarceration that too within two days, while the petitioner was in jail further debarring the petitioner from appearing in the examination proposed to be conducted on 08.07.2023 and all such examinations both physical and written conducted by TSPSC in future holding his involvement in crime no 64/2023 reregistered as Cr No 95/2023 on the file of CCS/DD/SIT by calling for all the records related to and connected to Show Cause Notice No 166/Admn/2023 and consequentially quash/set aside the same as such and consequently declare that the petitioner is entitled to

participate for all the recruitment examinations including departmental examinations to be conducted by the TSPSC and consequently direct the Respondent No.2 to permit the petitioners to write and participate in the ensuing Competitive examination to be held on 08.07.2023 with all consequential benefits like appointment, selection etc by declaring the above said notice as Illegal, Arbitrary Un Constitutional, being violative of Articles 19, 21 and 320 of the Constitution of India, against the Letter and spirit of Catena of Judgments rendered by this Honorable Court as well that of Honorable Supreme Court of India apart from being violative of principles of natural Justice.

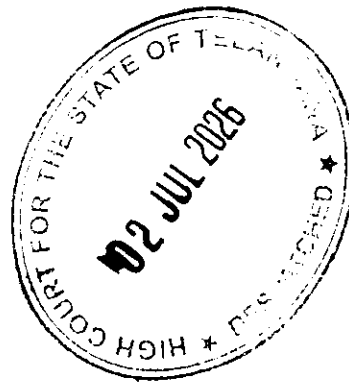
