Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent no.4 to 3 are interfering with the peaceful possession of the petitioner patta land in Sy.No. 193/A4/1 an extent of Ac.0.21 gts situated at Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District vide Katha No. 1813 belongs to the petitioner without following due process of law and without issuing any notice and without jurisdiction to the petitioner is illegal, arbitrary and violation principles of natural justice and also violation article 14, 19 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently directs the respondents not to dispossess/interfering from the petitioner agriculture land.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to directs the respondents not to dispossess/interfering from the petitioner agriculture land Sy.No 193/A4/1 an extent of Ac.0.21 gts situated at Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District forthwith pending disposal of the main writ petition.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VENKATARAMANAI AH KANDULA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP For Revenue for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government for Revenue.

Petitioner claims to be pattadar and possessor on the strength of Pattadar Pass Book No.T29190121113 in respect of land in an extent of Ac.0.21 guntas in Sy.No.193/A4/1, Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to the respondents No.3 and 4 not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioner in respect of land in an extent of Ac.0.21 guntas in Sy.No.193/A4/1, Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District, without following due process of law.
