Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of Respondent No. 4 in issuing eviction proceedings in File No. 750/PROG/WAQF/WGL/2025 dated 07.05.2026 directing Respondent Nos. 5, 6 and

8 to evict the petitioner from Shop No. 1, bearing Municipal No. 14-39/1 Star Foot Wear, situated in the Jama Masjid Complex, Thorrur, Ground Floor, First Shutter, admeasuring approximately 300 square feet (12 feet x 20 feet), without considering the petitioners representations dated 04.05.2026 and 11.05.2026, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, violative of the principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India, and to set aside the same and consequently direct the respondents no. 4 to 9 not to interfere with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Shop No. 1, bearing Municipal No. 14-39/1 Star Foot Wear, situated in the Jama Masjid Complex, Thorrur, Ground Floor, First Shutter, admeasuring approximately 300 square feet (12 feet into 20 feet), and further direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's request for renewal of lease by fixing fair market rent in accordance with law.

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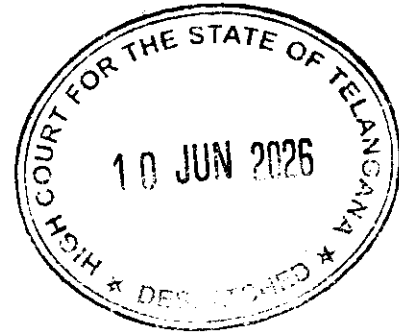
