Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the acts of the respondent No2 of interfering with work of the petitioner of sonography and other scans under the pretext that validity of the PC PNDT certificate expired in spite of submission of explanation dated 27-04-2026 to the show cause notice dated 22-04-2026 of the respondent No2 vide RCNo01/PCPNDT/2026 and also several judicial precedents and government orders and also said show cause notice as illegal arbitrary unconstitutional high handed violative of principles of natural justice etc to set aside them and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the work of the petitioner of sonogrwhy and other scans in the interest of justice

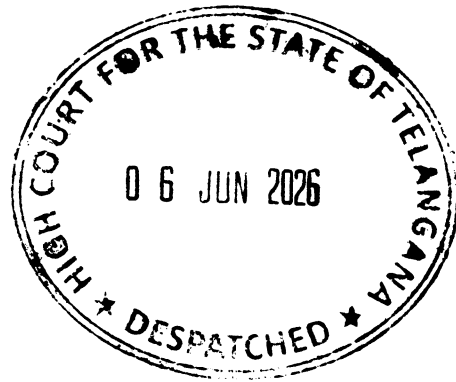
