Petition under Section 482 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased grant anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, directing that in the event of arrest of the Petitioner, Challa Raju, S/o Yedukondalu, in connection with Crime No. 167 of 2026, Mokila Police Station, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit; and pass such other order or orders may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri ARBAZ KHAN, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Jithender Rao Veeramalla, the Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2.

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') by the petitioner/accused No.4 seeking to enlarge him on Anticipatory Bail in the event of his arrest in Crime No.167 of 2026 of Mokila Police Station, Future City District, registered for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 308(2), 351(2), 61 r/w 3(5) of BNS.

2. Heard Ms.Aatika Almas Sadaf, learned counsel representing Mr.Arbaz Khan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent - State.

3. Without going into the merits of the case, since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner is less than seven (07) years, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer on or before 15.06.2026 between 11:00 a.m. and 05:00 p.m. and in turn, the Investigating Officer is directed to follow the procedure laid down under Section 35 (3) of BNSS (previously Section 41-A of Cr.P.C.) and also the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar**¹ scrupulously. However, the petitioner shall submit his defense and co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required by furnishing information and produce all relevant documents/material required for the purpose of the investigation and the Investigating Officer shall consider the same before filing appropriate report before the learned Magistrate concerned.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.

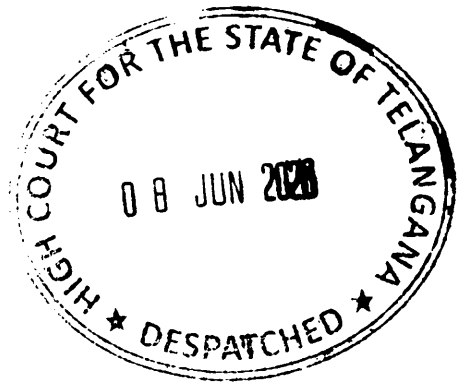
