Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass such an order or direction or writ, more so in nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring, i. the action of Respondent No.3 in issuing impugned disposal of objections Dt. 22-05-2026 without hearing to the petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violation of principles of natural justice and, ii. Consequently, direct the respondents more particularly Respondent No.5, not to issue election notification to the 4th respondent Society, in furtherance with the objection disposal proceedings Dt. 22-05-2026 and iii. Consequently, set aside the impugned disposal of objections issued by the 3rd Respondent Dt. 22-05-2026 and direct the Respondents to remove the respondent No. 7 to 10 names from final voter list of the 4th Respondent Society.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of the impugned disposal of objections issued by the 3rd Respondent Dt. 22-05-2026 and remove the respondent No.7 to 10 names from final voter list of the 4th Respondent Society till disposal of Writ Petition.

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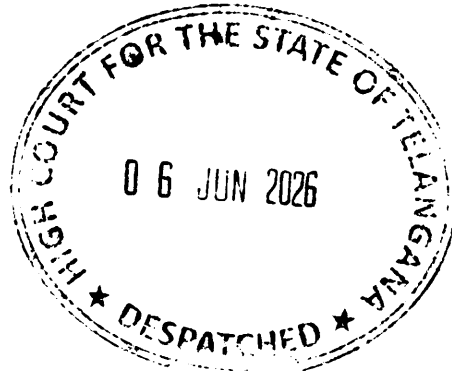
