and without impleading the petitioner being the son and legal heir of the deceased Perasani Venkata Rama Rao in C.C.No.43 of 2025, as illegal, arbitrary, against to the principles of natural justice and violation of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently to set aside the same directing the 6th respondent to implead the petitioner in C.C. No.43 of 2025 for proper adjudication of the case

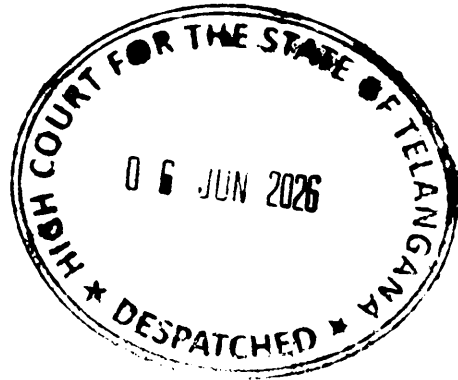
