Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondent No 2 in interfering with the civil dispute between the Petitioner and the 3rd Respondent in respect of the schedule property, which is the subject matter of Vacation O.S. No.54 of 2026, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondent No 2 not to interfere with the civil dispute, title, possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner over the schedule property, except in accordance with law.

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed seeking to grant the following relief:

"...to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent No.2 in interfering with the civil dispute between the petitioner and the 3rd respondent in respect of the schedule property which is the subject matter of I.A.No.889 of 2026 in Vacation O.S.No.54 of 2026, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondent No.2 not to interfere with the civil dispute, title, possession

and enjoyment of the petitioner over the schedule property except in accordance with law and pass..."

2. Heard Sri Bandi Sai Vamshi, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2.

3. The grievance of the petitioner that, the respondent No.2-police is interfering with the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.3 in respect of the schedule property in O.S.No.54 of 2026, despite pendency of civil proceedings before the competent Civil Court.

4. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner reiterated the contentions raised in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, and contended that the respondent-police authorities are interfering with the civil disputes of the petitioner, at the behest of unofficial respondent.

5. *Per contra*, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home would contend upon receipt of complaint from the petitioner, respondent No.2 investigated into the matter and closed the case as civil in nature and that they are neither

calling the petitioner to the police station nor interfering with the civil rights of the petitioner at the behest of respondent No.3.

6. Recording the above said submissions, the writ petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
