HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents, on telephonic instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the services of petitioner have been regularized and her benefits already stands released; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

[2] In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[3] However, in case, any claim of the petitioner still survives, she would be at liberty to raise her claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of four weeks from dispatch by the concerned branch, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two

weeks thereafter.

[4] Since, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, let a copy of this order be sent to her by the concerned branch.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
