DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. There is no representation on behalf of the appellant, despite the fact that Mr. Sanjeev Sharma, Advocate, who was representing the appellant, has been duly informed through e-mail, as reported by the Registry.
2. A perusal of the file reveals that a simple suit for permanent injunction was filed by the appellant Giani Ram, which was dismissed by the learned trial Court on 30.04.1999. The said judgment was upheld by the learned First Appellate Court on 19.10.2001. Thus, the present second appeal has been filed against the concurrent findings dismissing the suit for permanent injunction.
3. Since nobody is appearing on behalf of the appellant, it is presumed that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the appeal.



Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, in case any cause of action still survives, the appellant is at liberty to get the same revived.
