1. This is an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 238 days in filing the appeal.

2. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the present application is allowed and delay of 238 days in filing the present appeal is condoned.

Main case

1. Injured-claimant has filed the present appeal for enhancement of compensation. The Tribunal had awarded an amount of Rs.38,130/- along with interest for the injuries suffered by the appellant in a motor vehicular accident. The only issue that arises in the present case is as to whether the



present appellant is entitled to additional amount of compensation or not.

2. During the course of arguments, it has been jointly stated on behalf of the appellant as well as on behalf of respondent No.2-Insurance Company that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and it has been decided that respondent No.2-Insurance Company would pay an additional amount of compensation of Rs.2,10,000/- (including interest) to the appellant as a full and final settlement.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present appeal is disposed of and the impugned award is modified and respondent No.2-Insurance Company is directed to pay an additional amount of compensation of Rs.2,10,000/- (including interest) to the appellant as a full and final settlement within a period of six weeks from today.
