1. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the parties. On the previous date also, none was present. Counsels were informed by the Registry but even then none has put in appearance. This is an appeal pending since the year 2002, and no one has appeared for the parties, so, it seems that no one is interested in pursuing the instant appeal.
