SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 12.08.2025 passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Charkhi Dadri, whereby, respondents/defendants No.1, 2 and 4 were restrained from interfering in the possession of the petitioner/plaintiff over the disputed vehicle.

2. A perusal of the case file shows that the appropriate remedy available to the petitioner is to move an application under Order 39 Rule 2A CPC before learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Charkhi Dadri. Despite



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the availability of the said alternative remedy, the petitioner has chosen to file the present contempt petition.

3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is **dismissed**, with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy as is available to him in accordance with law.
