1. Through the instant petition, as cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenge is thrown to the order dated 28.02.2002 (Annexure P-7), wherethrough, the petitioner has been allotted a free seat at Mai Bhago Ayurvedic College, Muktsar, in BAMS Course under General Category. She also seeks a *mandamus* upon the respondents to allow her to study in BAMS course in Government Ayurvedic College at Patiala. She has also prayed that refund of Rs.10,000/- which was deposited by her alongwith the waiting list Form of General Category.

2. The instant petition, was ordered to be admitted way back on 06.03.2002, and the petitioner as allowed to continue her studies in Government Ayurvedic College at Patiala.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, today in Court. It seems that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed, as the petitioner must have completed her BAMS course. Accordingly, this Court is of the considered view that no cause of action survives in the present petition.

4. Therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be **dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner, to revive the instant petition by filing an apt motion, in case the cause of action still survives.
